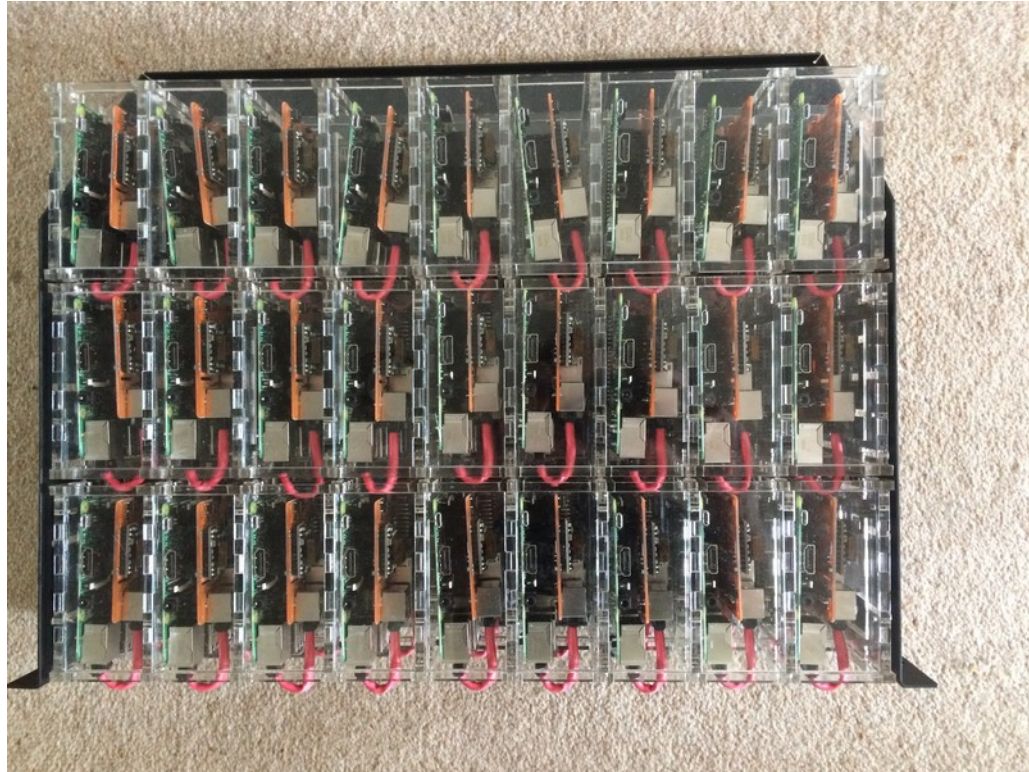
What we did

- Nothing!
- IPv6 was enabled on our company website and control panels.
- Two weeks later, once it was clear it all worked we turned it on by default for all hosting customers (thousands).

IPv6 only VMs (launched 2014)

- We have an IPv6 only VM
- It has outbound via DNS64/NAT64
- It has inbound for SSL & HTTP via our proxy service
- You can host real websites with it (~10,000)
