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- Updated Policy Development Process

- RIPE Task Forces: Definitions and Guidelines
- Successful online RIPE Meetings during pandemic
- Promoting RIPE community in various forums
- Increased outreach to new RIPE participants

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# RIPE Code of Conduct Updates

# Code of Conduct Task Force

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- Updated RIPE Code of Conduct published in Oct 2021 (ripe-766)
- Two new documents published
  - Updated version of the reporting process
  - Code of Conduct Team formation
- RIPE Labs article summarising feedback
- Drop-in sessions at RIPE 85
- Updated set of documents after RIPE 85

# Code of Conduct Feedback: Right to a defence

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- Currently this is the first step in the assessment of a report:
  - “Contact subject of report to hear their side of the story”
- If the team does not believe a report warrants any further investigation or discussion, this might not be necessary
- Language will be clarified in the document

# Code of Conduct Feedback: Anonymity

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- Anonymity of the reporter (optional)
  - Important to allow reports about community members in power
- Anonymity of the reported
  - Team will not disclose names publicly unless unavoidable
- Anonymous reports
  - Common practice in other communities
  - Might not carry the same weight



# Impartiality of the Code of Conduct Team

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- It's all about trust
- Team will include members with a range of skills and expertise
- Integrity is important
- RIPE Chair will select team members
  - Based on community feedback
- Details how team members will be indemnified will be added

# Code of Conduct: Next Steps

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- Clarify the Code of Conduct team's duty to contact a reported party and hear their side of the story
- Clarify how serious reports will be handled
- Adjust the section regarding personal data
- Add text indemnifying team members
- Issue call for volunteers for the Code of Conduct team

# RIPE Nominating Committee Recommendations

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- RIPE NomCom's final report (ripe-762)
- Four recommendations to community:
  1. Document relationship between RIPE NCC and RIPE
  2. Document community consensus about remuneration of RIPE Chairs
  3. Updates to RIPE NomCom document (ripe-728)
  4. Updates to RIPE Chair Selection Process (ripe-727)

# Updates to RIPE docs on NomCom

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- A simple reserve list is sufficient for our process
- Random process will only run once
  - Ordered reserves list of volunteers who can be called upon
- Timeline for getting NomCom organised
  - Changed from 60 days to 90 days prior to the consultation RIPE Meeting
- **Next steps:** Consensus call on changes to ripe-728 and ripe-728 on the RIPE list after RIPE 85

# Outreach and Events

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- Online session for students prior to RIPE 85
- Continue to participated in industry events
- Make sure RIPE continues to be present in Internet Governance and technical coordination events
