Recent discussion

- Long intense discussion
- Chairs agree there is consensus on geolocation as a purpose
- Without clear purpose, limits needed
- RIPE NCC limits by prefix length or status not acceptable by community

GDPR

- GDPR needs dedicated, specific purposes for processing personal data
- Old style, generalised, catch all purposes not sufficient
- 'Facilitating coordination between network operators for agreed operational purposes' is too vague

- Let's focus on geolocation
- Agree on the wording for a dedicated, defined purpose of the database for geolocation
- Volunteer to suggest some wording for purpose?
- Update the purposes

- Never been done before
- Purposes defined in Terms & Conditions (legal document)
- DB WG consensus sufficient for NCC to update the T&C
 - Covered by Article 8
- Or do we need to go via PDP?
- EB approval may be needed...
